ABOUT US


The Aspinall Foundation is run in conjunction with Howletts and Port Lympne Wild Animal Parks. We are devoted to the protection and breeding of rare and endangered species with the ultimate aim of returning them back to the wild wherever possible.

The Aspinall Foundation was established as a registered charity in 1984. John Aspinall, the founder, dreamt of returning rare and endangered animals back to their natural habitats. The Foundation now successfully runs its own conservation projects overseas and supports reintroduction programmes across Asia and Africa.

There are now over 16,000 endangered species struggling to survive mainly due to habitat loss, hunting, pollution and conflict with humans worldwide. By conserving and protecting natural habitats and endangered species we can help to halt the next global mass extinction.

Over the past few years we have sent a range of animals back to the wild including 8 black rhino, 49 Javan langurs, 9 Javan gibbon, 11 European bison and over 60 Western lowland gorillas.

A big part of conservation is education. Increasing public awareness of the importance of animal welfare and how we can all act to protect animals and their natural environments can really make a difference.



WHY WE NEED YOU Looking after animals in captivity and getting them ready for a life in the wild is no easy task. We have the experience and skills to run successful reintroduction projects proven for over 30 years. However, we can only do this with your help. 

HELP US HALT MASS EXTINCTION

The Megafauna project was set up restore the environment in the Batéké Plateau National Park in Gabon.

The Aspinall Foundation has been protecting one million acres of wildlife habitat in Congo and Gabon for 30 years. It is the home of our Gorilla project and through our work in this area we have helped other species. Including the first sighting of a lion in 20 years! We are on the brink of mass extinction globally.

With your help we can ensure wild areas like these are protected for generations to come. Unless we all step up and take urgent action now, there will be no lions, elephants or gorillas left in our children's world.

THE MILE CHALLENGE

Help our animals get back to the wild!

Our Back to the Wild initiative has seen over 200 animals successfully reintroduced to the wild around the world. Many of these animals have travelled thousands of miles from our parks in Kent.

For example, when we send a critically endangered Western lowland gorilla back to the wild they travel approximately 3800 miles from Kent to their new home in Africa. This costs us approximately £1500 for the flight. By fundraising for us, you will be directly helping us to send more animals back to the wild.

The Mile Challenge is a fun way for anyone to get involved in fundraising for our back to the wild programmes. Ask a friend or family member to challenge you to complete 1, 5, 10 or even 100 miles, however many you like! You can complete your challenge by walking, running, skating, swimming, space hopping or any fun way you can think of that doesn't use an electric motor!

Fundraising in aid of The Aspinall Foundation

Thank you for raising funds for us. Published guidelines mean that we need to ensure that our supporters understand that they are raising funds in aid of the charity, but don't represent us. Please do not talk about The Aspinall Foundation policies or stance on specific issues (for example in press releases, in publicity or other materials for your event). Any queries should be referred to our Fundraising Team.

Insurance

Please remember that you are responsible for the activity and for making sure it is run safely and legally. The Aspinall Foundation cannot accept any liability or responsibility for anything that might happen to people or property as a result of your fundraising activity. If you are planning an event that involves the general public in any way you'll need to take into account public liability insurance.

Collecting Money

If you want to collect donations at your event, please be aware that public collections do need specific permission and licences, depending on the venue. We don't advise that you collect money door to door or as part of street collection, as it's illegal to do so without a licence. Please make sure any coins and notes donated are kept in a secure location and are then banked safely.

Gift Aid
