



## Who are we?

The Aspinall Foundation (TAF) is a leading animal conservation charity, based in Kent, devoted to the conservation of endangered species, and returning them to areas of protected wilderness.

Since 1984 we have delivered ground-breaking work across multiple countries, species and projects, and are committed to challenging, often world first, rewilding projects.

We work in some of the world's most fragile environments to save endangered animals, combining captive breeding, education, reintroduction, and habitat protection through our overseas projects across three continents. Our global conservation work, spanning over 35 years, covers issues such as the illegal wildlife trade, the recovery of threatened species and the protection of their natural home through community-based conservation.





### Why Is Our Work Important?

We are the dominant species on the planet and as such, we should be custodians for nature. We have spent too long destroying our precious environments and The Aspinall Foundation is committed to redressing the balance, by working to restore and protect animals and their habitats around the world.

We believe that animals deserve, wherever possible, to live in their natural environments, free from persecution by humans – from hunting, trapping and loss of their habitat. For too long humans have threatened and destroyed the forests, plains and rivers that animals live in. We have a responsibility, a duty, to tackle this destruction and rebuild the population of the far too many endangered animals facing the threat of extinction.







Animals thought impossible to be reintroduced back into the wild can thrive in protected habitats of their native land.

## The Difference Your Support Could Make
