

## THE LIST OF REQUIREMENTS FOR A SUCCESSFUL WILDLIFE MISSION IS SUBSTANTIAL AND SOMETIMES VARIED, BUT COLLABORATION AND SPEED ARE TWO ESSENTIAL COMPONENTS.

On the 31st January this year, the Bongani Mountain Lodge in South Africa was the subject of a suspected arson attack. Fortunately, there were no guests at the lodge and all staff were evacuated safely, but the lodge itself was burnt to the ground. The lodge was situated in the Mthethomusha Game Reserve, which shares its borders with the Kruger National Park, and is home to an abundant and diverse range of wildlife. Two of the rhinos were in close proximity to each other and captured together, with a final stage in the mission required to capture the remaining animal.

#### A complex operation

Within days, The Aspinall
Foundation, in partnership with
WILDTRUST and the Wildlife
Emergency Fund, collaborated with
the Mpumalanga Tourism and Parks
Agency (MTPA) to provide
assistance. Less than three weeks
from the date of the fire, three
female rhino had been
successfully moved to Care for
Wild, a rhino sanctuary, where they
will be well cared for until they can
be placed in a suitable long-term
setting.

The rescue took place in stages.
First, the team had to assess the situation and locate the rhinos. They then had to wait for the rhinos to be in strategic locations and close to the boundary of the reserve before the capture operations could take place. Two of the rhinos were in close proximity to each other and captured together, with a final stage in the mission required to capture the remaining animal. Dereck Milburn, our South Africa Regional Director, said:
"Mthethomusha has very difficult

terrain to work in, but the mission could not have gone better."
"This was largely due to the expertise and collaboration of all those involved".

#### Mozambique elephants

Our translocation expertise proved invaluable yet again in May, when a herd of 13 elephants had to be moved urgently. The elephants had been roaming in the buffer zone of the Maputo Special Reserve, a 400-square-mile protected area which was founded in 1932 on the coast of Mozambique.

The herd had come into conflict with local communities and there were calls for them to be culled. It was clear that time was limited if the elephants were to be saved. The Aspinall Foundation collaborated with Mozambique's National Administration of Conversation Areas (ANAC), Peace Parks Foundation and The Wildlife Emergency fund to plan and accomplish the move. Translocation specialists Conservation Solutions and the Mozambique Wildlife Alliance both provided their services to realise the complex mission.

The transfer required considerable expertise, including an expert helicopter pilot flying close to the herd, whilst a vet used a dart gun to sedate each elephant. Amazing accuracy given he was aiming at a moving target from a moving helicopter! In one of the most challenging translocations we have been involved in so far, all 13 elephants were transferred safely to their new home at Zinave National Park.

# REHABILITATED JAVAN LANGURS RELEASED BACK TO THE WILD

Our Aspinall Foundation Indonesia team, headed by Made Wedana, is achieving great success with our Back to the Wild programme. In this update, we bring you news of their work with just one species: the East Javan ebony langur

#### A new life in the wild

Earlier this year, after a visit to prepare the site at the protected area that is to be their new home, the team placed the selected langurs, two males and five females, into individual transportation crates. After checking they had settled after their transfer from the Centre to the release site, the group were released on 25th March 2021. Each release is to be celebrated, each animal given back its birthright of a life in the wild, but it is also the culmination of months of hard work which will continue with those yet to be released.

#### **Ongoing preparations**

Whilst the monitoring team are taking daily observations of the newly-released group, there is only time for a deep clean of their empty cages back at the Centre before they are filled again with more langurs. There is a constant process of monitoring and assessment, and animals will pass through a number



of health checks, quarantine and socialisation phases before eventual release. Before the end of April, another group - one male and three females - was selected for release in July 2021. Aside from a pre-release medical, the group are observed in detail on a daily basis, the team keeping a good distance to ensure the behaviour they observe is not influenced by the proximity of


humans. Social cohesion is important, and a group that has developed a good social bond will cope better when released.

#### Wide-ranging support

The work is both rewarding and extensive. In addition to the release preparations, the Centre also receives confiscated/rescued

animals, provides dedicated care for all resident langurs, carries out regular maintenance of the site, monitors the groups already living in the wild, and is involved in community support such as educational visits. In recent months, this is still being achieved, despite Indonesia facing intense pressure from the coronavirus pandemic. Java, in particular, has been very badly affected. It is so important that this work continues. and our team in Indonesia is hugely grateful for the support you give. Without you, much of the work would simply not be possible. 8 9





Madagascar's stunningly rich biodiversity stands in stark contrast to the extreme poverty of the island, particularly in rural areas. Yet whilst the subsistence lifestyle of many communities poses a threat to the natural environment, it also provides an opportunity. Through community-based conservation projects, it is possible to make the changes needed to improve living standards in a way that both builds the capacity of local people and utilises the knowledge of sustainable farming methods and land use. This formula is the basis for the work carried out by The Aspinall Foundation's Madagascar team.

#### Lemur projects

Our mission to protect lemurs and their habitats continues with community supported projects in the core sites at Andriantantely and Ambato-Boeny.

Despite increased pressures due to

the coronavirus pandemic, two of our species-specific projects, supported by IUCN Save Our Species, have seen the number of lemurs increase across all seven of the target species. This is wonderful news, and we hope to continue and expand on this work going forward.

Yet the variety of vulnerable species and habitats on the island highlights the need for much more to be done. Participatory surveys in

the wetlands of the Maevatanana/
Ambato-Boeny region provided us with a strong indication that several species, including some of the world's most Critically Endangered, would benefit from the implementation of conservation strategies in the area.

#### The power of community

Thanks to the support of the Critical Ecosystem Partnership Fund, we have been able to spend the past four and a half years developing hard-won community relationships and collecting valuable data on Critically Endangered species such as the Madagascan fisheagle, the Madagascan bigheaded turtle, and an endemic cichlid fish known as damba mipentina. Other Endangered and Vulnerable species are also present, including the Madagascan flying fox, the Madagascan pond heron, and other species of cichlid.

#### A fighting chance

Our achievements so far include the designation of almost 4,000 hectares of freshwater lakes for improved community-based management - and we are keen to maintain a presence in this area for the foreseeable future.

Without support, at least some of these species will become extinct. For example, it is estimated there may be as few as 120 breeding pairs of Madagascan fish-eagles. They only breed once a year, and only one chick will fledge for each pair per year. Last year, we discovered five nest sites at four lakes in the project site. Every chick that can survive to adulthood, and breed, is one more chance for survival of the species.

### OUR LATEST EXCITING REWILDING PROJECT

Earlier this year, Joshi made the greatest journey of his life as he flew to Congo to begin his life as a wild gorilla. This incredible journey took just 36 hours, our fastest transfer yet, and upon arrival, Joshi stayed in a custom-built habituation area to allow him to be monitored as he acclimatised to the new environment and diet. Here, he was introduced to Loukelela and Bomassa, two orphaned gorillas, who featured in our spring Wildcry. The three gorillas were then integrated into one enclosure, where they got to know each other.

#### **Next steps**

The gorillas will spend a year or so on the island. At this point, they will be able to move to the wider Lesio-Louna Reserve. Here, they will live a fully wild life, meeting the other gorillas on the reserve. It is hoped that in time they will breed with female gorillas here and further boost the gorilla population in an area where they were previously hunted to extinction.


The orphans will help to teach Joshi how to live wild, showing him which vegetation to eat, and Joshi will provide protection for them due to his size.



## AN EPIC JOURNEY

#### Onto the island

Recently, Joshi, Loukelela and Bomassa have made their next move, to a protected island in the Lesio-Louna reserve. This move will allow them to live as wild gorillas, while also allowing our expert team to monitor them, supplement their food and give them essential medicine.

The Aspinall Foundation is proud of its long history of rewilding gorillas. Over three decades, it has successfully reintroduced over 70 gorillas into the wild, with over 30 births to reintroduced animals.

## In our previous issue of Wildcry, we updated you on our incredible cheetah rewilding projects

Our much-loved Port Lympne-born cheetah brothers, Saba and Nairo, have been making fantastic progress in the vast expanse of South Africa's Great Karoo, following their transfer from Howletts back in February 2020.

In other exciting news, captive-born cheetah brothers Kumbe and Jabari are thriving on a 4,500 hectare reserve in Zimbabwe, following their February transfer from Parc Safari in Canada. The transfer was managed by The Aspinall Foundation

in collaboration with Parc Safari, Imire Rhino & Wildlife Conservation and Ethiopian Airlines.

Below, we take a look at the progress of these two projects in more detail:

#### Saba and Nairo

On 17th February 2021, The Aspinall Foundation team released Saba & Nairo from their training camp onto the main reserve at Mount Camdeboo. Free to run and hunt under cloudless skies in the shadow of the mighty Sneeuberg range, the brothers are now entirely self-sufficient, effortlessly taking down large prey such as kudu with

a cheetah's characteristic pace and dexterity. They are being discreetly monitored using satellite and telemetry tracking collars by The Aspinall Foundation and Mount Camdeboo teams as they explore their expansive new home.

In the midst of their first South
African winter, they experienced
their first snowfall in Mount
Camdeboo, sporting well
conditioned winter coats and
hunting and eating exceptionally
well. In time, the spirited pair will
encounter females and, when nature
takes its course, will contribute their
valuable genetics to the South
African cheetah metapopulation.

#### **Kumbe and Jabari**

Back in February this year, The Aspinall Foundation lent its expertise to a first-of-its-kind project for Zimbabwe. Cheetah brothers Kumbe and Jabari undertook a 7,600-mile journey from Parc Safari in Quebec to Imire Rhino & Wildlife Conservation in Mashonaland East district. Following a flight aboard a Boeing 787-9 Dreamliner in specially-designed transport crates, they arrived safely at Imire after a 30-hour journey.

The pair then spent 60 days in a quarantine boma acclimatising to their new environment whilst being monitored closely by the Imire and

Aspinall Foundation teams. Before their release, the brothers were given health checks then fitted with tracking collars to carefully observe their behaviour.

Upon their release into the spectacular sprawling plains of the main Imire reserve, these two top predators wasted no time in demonstrating their instinctual hunting prowess, making their first successful kill within 12 hours of their release – a proud moment for our teams.

The programme, supported by the Zimbabwe government, is significant for being the first of its kind for the country, which has never before received captive-bred cheetahs

for rewilding.

### Celebrating success, looking to the future

We are delighted with the incredible success of these groundbreaking projects, which have proven that these magnificent captive-born cats can be successfully rewilded, yielding amazing results.

We are already working with other organisations to replicate our trailblazing programmes and repopulate other reserves with these beautiful animals.

We will continue to bring you updates on the brothers' thrilling stories in future issues.

## **BEARS**

July saw the exciting arrival at Port Lympne of a family of European brown bears. Rescued from a zoo in Andorra, they are now exploring their new custom-built three-acre woodland enclosure.

The bears - named Julio, Encam and Neu, and their young cubs - were transported 800 miles from Naturlandia, Andorra's only zoo, which was part of an amusement park. The decision to transfer them to Port Lympne was made following the announcement by Naturlandia's director, Xabier Ajona, that the Andorran zoo would be closing, as there were limitations on what it was able to achieve from a conservation perspective.

To facilitate the move, Port Lympne Reserve worked in partnership with Bears In Mind, an organisation which works to provide better living conditions for captive bears.

Their rescue was possible due to your generous support, which helped to raise the funds for the transfer and the custom-built enclosure. Specially designed by the park's expert team, the spacious enclosure includes water features, den areas and plenty of vegetation, allowing the bears to live the most natural life possible.

We are delighted to have finally welcomed these captivating animals, and our immense gratitude goes to all those who helped facilitate the move.





## LIONS

On 14th June 2021, we were delighted to announce the arrival of four lion cubs at Port Lympne, born to mum Oudrika and dad, Adras. Now third time parents, Adras and Oudrika have been keeping a watchful eye over the four adventurous youngsters as they explore their surroundings.

Currently located in an enclosure adjacent to the reserve's Lion Lodge and Pinewood cabins, the cubs, along with the adults in the eight-strong pride, will very soon be moving into a new eight-acre, custom-built, fully open-top habitat.

With these latest adorable arrivals, Oudrika is the proud mother of eight cubs. Khari, Binti and Kulinda from Oudrika's first litter live with their parents at Port Lympne. Azi, from Oudrika's second litter, is thriving under the care of the dedicated team at Howletts.
